

1509.9 nautical miles from the Karl Heine Kanal

Etty Yaniv's installation comprises drawings and photographs on recycled paper and plastic fragments. The artwork features a wall relief, a sculptural piece based on a column, and a series of collages. This project took place at the Leipziger Baumwollspinnerei as part of the One Sided Story project in Leipzig, Germany. Yaniv stayed at the residency for over three months, creating the artwork on-site and later exhibiting it publicly. The installation was specifically designed to be responsive to the site, incorporating the surrounding environment into the work. The title of the installation alludes to the geographical distance between Tel Aviv, Israel, and Leipzig, Germany, signifying the layered biographical and historical interconnections that the artwork explores.
